## Judgement Delivered

### IN THE SAMSON vs. ARCHIBALD MOTOR CASE.

The motor case upon which a great deal of public interest was centered, ended yesterday. Constable G. Samson had lodged a complaint against Henry D. Archibald of Harbour Grace, charging that the Defendant, by using a motor car on the public street of St. John's without being registered, committed a breach of sub-section (4) of section (2) Chapter 57 of the Consolidated Statutes, Third Series, entitled "Of Motor Vehicles."

Section (2) referred to in the charge is as follows:—"Every motor car owned or operated within the limits of the town of St. John's shall be registered with the St. John's Municipal Council and the said Council shall assign a separate number to every car registered with it."

Mr. Morine, K.C., who appeared for the defence, proved (1) the Defendant was a resident of Harbour Grace; (2) that he did not own or operate a motor car within the limits of the town of St. John's, and contended that the Defendant's car was not subject to registration under the Act.

I hold sub-section (4) under which the prosecution is taken cannot apply to the car driven by the Defendant. Section (2) only compels the registration of motor cars owned and operated within the limits of the town of St. John's. I therefore dismiss the complaint.

## Prisoners Brought From West Coast.

### POLICE CONSTABLE GIVEN LONG CHASE

Two prisoners, Arthur and Andrew Young, were brought to the city by yesterday's express by Constable J. Dempsey, to serve long terms for larceny. Arthur Young, who received an 18 months term, led the police of a long chase before being captured. For a considerable time he had been raiding private houses at Port au Port and when Constable Dempsey got on the trail he took to the woods, finally reaching Mole Point, Bay St. George. It was here after an eleven days chase that Constable Dempsey made the capture.

Andrew Young, the other prisoner, has been given a six months term. Both were tried at Bay St. George by the Supreme Court in Circuit.

## Received a 12 Months' Sentence.

A young man Maidment, who was recently arrested at Bay of Islands in connection with several burglaries at the Post Office, was given a 12 months term in the Penitentiary by the Supreme Court in Circuit. The prisoner was brought to the city in charge of Constable Quinan on yesterday's express, to serve his sentence.

## Monster Tuna.

A tuna fish, weighing 1,600 pounds the largest ever caught in New Jersey waters, was landed on July 20th at Manasquan by a crew of the Manasquan Fish Company. The fish weighing 100 pounds more than another of the same species caught by the same company a few days ago. The crew, under Captain Holding, struggled with the monster for two hours and were finally compelled to dive into the water to shake it with ropes after it had smashed to pieces two sets of tackle. Some of the crew were injured in their efforts to hoist the fish into their boat. It was fourteen feet long.

## Atlantic Salmon.

Distribution of 10,000 Atlantic salmon eggs in the eyed stage and 10,252,000 Atlantic salmon fry has been made in the more important salmon streams of the maritime provinces. The fry were distributed in a free swimming state and after their food sac was absorbed. In addition, there are nearly 4,000 fry in the various hatcheries which will be fed and will not be liberated until they have attained some growth.
