Those who have lived in Great Britain or Ireland, know how strikingly it contrests with the permanency of the situations of teachers in those countries. How often this circumstance is deplored by parents as well as teachers; and yet he evil continues. As matters stand, no eacher can connt on holding his situation longer than a year, however efficient he may be. Hence, as a general thing, eachers make their profession a stepping-tone to some other calling, and after a few years abandon it to other youthful spirants, who in turn follow their footteps, just at the time when they begin cally to know how to discharge aright he responsible duties imposed on them. So long as this state of things continues, he cause of education will be retarded; and, instead of schools being wrought up to the bighest state of efficiency by teachers of long-experience and thorough fasiliarity with their work, they will be sit to the management of novitiates purning their calling more from necessity han choice, and longing for the day hen something permanent shall turn up and rid them of the capticious uncertaines of scholastic employment. Instead of engaging a teacher year by year, let im receive his appointment with the uncerstanding that he shall retain it so long as he gives satisfaction and that he shall to be dismisced, nor relinquish his post, ithout at least three months' previous otice.
