

Practical Talks and Plain Precepts for Farmers.

IN BREEDING. Improving animals by breeding together is a very important part of the farmer's business. The selection of the best stock is the key to success.

CROSS-BREEDING. Strictly speaking crossbreeding is the pairing of animals of distinct breeds and the resulting stock may be considered the offspring of an animal of one breed and one of another.

Selection of stock. In selecting stock to sire any of these classes of stock, the farmer should insist upon the individuality and pedigree. The time when pedigree alone was considered sufficient is long past.

Production of a new breed. Crossbreeding has probably been carried on more in any country than in any other. It is a process of selection and improvement of stock.

Improvement of stock. The farmer should not only select the best stock but also improve it. This is done by careful breeding and selection.

Selection of a sire. The sire is the most important factor in the production of a new breed. He should be selected with care.

Selection of a dam. The dam is also an important factor. She should be selected with care and bred to the best sire.

Selection of a sire and dam. The selection of a sire and dam is the most important part of breeding. It determines the quality of the offspring.
