B E N J A M I N G I L B E R T, Son of Jofeph Gilbert, was born at Byberry, about 15 Miles from the City of Philadelphia, in the Year 1711, and received his Education among the People called Quakers.

He refided at or near the Place of his Nativity for feveral Years; during which Time of Refidence he married, and after the Deceafe of his firft Wife, he accomplifhed a fecond Marriage with Elizabeth Peart, Widow of Bryan Peart, and continued in this Neighbourhood until the Year 1775, when he removed with his Family to a Farm fituate on Mahoning Creek, in Penn Township, Northampton County, being the Frontiers of Pennfylvania,
