The Acting Secretary of State for External Affairs presents his compliments to the Ambassador of the United States of America and has the honor to refer to the Ambassador's Note No. 235 of April 13, 1959, concerning the proposed augmentation of communications facilities at Cape Dyer, Baffin Island, to support the Greenland Extension of the DEW Line (DEW EAST).

The proposals contained in the Ambassador's Note and the Annex to that Note are acceptable to the Government of Canada, and it is agreed that the Ambassador's Note and this reply should constitute an Agreement between the Canadian and United States Governments which shall be deemed to have come into effect on January 15, 1959, and which is to remain in effect for the same period as the Agreement of May 5, 1955* between the Canadian and United States Governments.
