By Mr. Anglin: —Order of The House, for a Return stating in detail the names of the several persons to whom was paid the sum of \$23,931, given in page 10 of the Report of the Minister of Railways, for the year ending June 30th, 1880, as the total sum paid for "Construction of Railways, old accounts" and charged to expenditure on capital account, the amount claimed, and the amount paid in each case, and the Report on which payment was made.

By Mr. Coursel:—Order of The House, for a Statement shewing the number of Boxes, Drawers and Pigeon-holes in the Montreal Post Office; the number of Boxes, Drawers and Pigeon-holes not let, before the rent was raised, and the number of those not let, since the rent was so raised.
