

Eighteenth of April,

Corporation in December 1916 apparently agreed to recognize the Students' organizations then listed in the Calendar.

The accepted report of the Committee stated:

"Of the Societies at present announced in the Calendar, some appear to have received the official recognition of Corporation; with others this does not appear to have been the case. The Committee does not desire to make any recommendations concerning these Societies."

List "A" gives the Societies named in the 1916-17 Calendar.

List "B" gives the Societies which have been approved by Corporation since then. This list includes some of list "A".

List "C" gives Societies started since 1916 and at present in existence (?) which have never been approved.

I think the whole situation needs clarifying.
