

require (except the individual is sick of some infectious disease.) They shall visit the sick in the following order:—The Kt. Rt. on Friday; No. 1 on Saturday; No. 2 on Sunday; No. 3 on Monday; No. 4 on Tuesday; No. 5 on Wednesday; No. 6 on Thursday; all of whom shall render a verbal report at each meeting of the Encampment until the Companion is declared well. And any of the Committee failing to visit at all shall be fined 1s. 3d. cy., sickness or absence from the city only excepted; The Committee shall be exempt from watching with the sick.

No. 8.—The Kt. Rt. shall be chairman of the Visiting Committee, and in case of the sickness of a Companion, he shall appoint in rotation two Companions to act as watchers (i. e. when required), who shall attend to such duties under a penalty of 1s. 3d., provided always that the disease be not contagious, infectious, or dangerous to others.

No. 9.—Whenever it may become known to the Encampment that any Knight or Companion has been reduced to a state of pecuniary distress by any sudden or unlooked-for dispensation of Providence, his case shall be referred to a special committee of three Com-
