

Sec. 5. Clubs competing for the Senior Championship must on or before the date of the meeting of the Senior Committee of Management in each year, deposit a Bond with at least one good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the said Committee of Management, in the penal sum of one hundred dollars, payable to the President of the Association, for the proper fulfilment of the Schedule as arranged. In the event of the condition of the Bond not being fulfilled, the President shall collect the same, and all legitimate expenses incurred by any other club in consequence of such non-fulfilment shall be paid out of the money forfeited, provided that the claim is found correct by the Judicial Committee, and the balance, if any, shall be handed over to the Treasurer of the Association.

Sec. 6. In the event of matches resulting in draws they shall not be counted, but shall be considered postponed matches; but if after the completion of the series, it be found that the standing of any club is affected by draws, they shall be played off under order of the President, the proceeds of all such matches to be equally divided.

Sec. 7. In case any clubs should tie on the whole series, they shall play off under order of the President, but in no case shall any match be ordered to be played later than the 1st of November.

Sec. 8. In case any club shall default any of the matches in the series it shall be ruled out of the series for the remainder of the season, and shall not be eligible to re-enter until the following season; all scheduled matches played by said club shall not be counted.

Sec. 9. Protests or complaints shall not interfere with fixed matches.

INTERMEDIATE AND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Sec. 10. The Intermediate and Junior District Committees of Management shall arrange a series consisting of an even number of matches between each of the clubs composing the District, to be played one-half on the home grounds of each club and the other half on the grounds of the other clubs.
