## A STRANGE LAW SUIT

Man Sues for Value of a Note Given Years Ago in Return for Kindness.

TORONTO, Sept. 28.—(Over) Over the King's court drew and they shall be heard.

The old archaic Norman-French court cry, used in England 800 years ago, when the King's justices first went upon their circuit, was heard in Toronto at the opening of the jury assizes.

Chief Justice Falconbridge, of the King's bench, sits in a sumptuously furnished court room, but one that has poorer acoustic properties than the original court held in the open air under the yew trees of medieval times.

A jury was speedily empaneled to try the case between George E. Davis of New York state, and the Trusts and Guarantee company, which is administering the estate of George Washington Todd who departed this life recently in Toronto.

This law suit has enticed about it all the elements of an old-fashioned romance. Down in Litchfield township, New York state, in the fall of 1867, the plaintiff, a young lad of sixteen, having just lost his father, was living with his mother and three sisters, managing the farm, in the winter he attended school. One evening in November, about 10 o'clock, while coming down a steep hill on the corner line he found an old man lying helpless and suffering great agony. This man, who made his regular rounds along the line, was an old fellow, thin, unkempt, hunched over and pack of "Yankee notions," well known in the neighborhood as George Washington Todd.

The man was helpless, and the young lad, like the Good Samaritan, well known in the neighborhood as George Washington Todd, took him in a bed in the little kitchen.
