

3. Quarter-boarders, — those who take their meals out of the college, \$30 00

4. Day-scholar, tuition only, \$16 00

N. B. The terms given in the three articles include the doctor's fees, and are payable, as well as those mentioned in art. 4th, half-yearly, in advance, viz.: On the day of admission and on the 1st of February. See art 14th for deductions.

5. Bed and bedding, with towels, napkins, knife, fork, and spoons, \$12 00

6. Bed, without bedding, 1 00

7. Washing, which must be done at the college for those who rent bed and bedding, 12 00

8. Piano, with use of instrument, 20 00

9. Use of the college library, 1 00

N. B. The terms mentioned in the last five articles are also payable, half-yearly, in advance, and no deduction, for absence is made for less than half a year.

10. No student is received without immediate payment of the first half-year's board as also all arrears, if there be any.

11. Interest may be required on arrears.

12. All necessary books can be procured at the college; the expenses of these, as well as of correspondance, to be charged to the students account.
