ALL ESCAPE IN AUTO THROUGH HAIL OF BULLETS

Was One of Most Sensational Jail Deliveries in State's History

HUNTSVILLE, Texas, July 22.—Two men believed to have been former inmates, shot and killed a guard at the Ferguson prison farm near here yesterday, and freed six convicts, in one of the most sensational prison deliveries in the history of Texas.

LIGHTS TURNED OFF When the shooting began the building tender, Pat McCoy, a trusty, switched off all lights in the prisoners' quarters. The man who did the shooting called out the names of six prisoners and told them to strike matches and get ready to leave. He went directly to the inner compartment and unlocked the door to the prisoners' lock up with keys taken from Rader.
