Hamilton, Ont., Sept. 13.—The will of Sir John Strathearn Hendrie, knight commander of St. Michael and St. George, former lieutenant-governor of Ontario and president of the Bank of Hamilton, has been entered for probate in the surrogate court by the Hon. S. C. Mewburn, acting for his widow, Lena Maude, Lady Hendrie, William Ian S. Hendrie and the Royal Trust Company, executrix and executors. Sir John, reputed to have the largest income of any man in Hamilton, left an estate valued at \$1,368,209.89 and this amount goes to his wife, children, relatives, servants and friends.

Out of the large estate is to be taken sufficient money by the executors to yield an annuity of \$15,000 per year for his wife and the residue will be divided between his son, Ian, and his daughter, Enid Strathern Owen, of Montreal. The trustees are also instructed in the will to take out of the Midren's share \$200,000 and from this they will get the income for life, but they have power to dispose of this money at their death.



T. M. Poulter, if in the employ of the Hendrie estate at the time of Sir John's death, gets \$5,000 and Walter B. Champ \$2,500 if he is actively engaged in any company in which the deceased was interested. The wife is to have the use of the household goods and chattels during her life.

In his estate are six shares of the Ontario Jockey Club, which are valued at \$1,000 each.




