

Hilaire Belloc, a British writer on military affairs, calculates that up to the middle of October the Germans suffered a loss of 1,750,000 men from "wastage." This includes men killed, wounded, captured and incapacitated. He states that the figure seems startlingly large, but that the estimate has been worked out upon a basis of irreducible minimums and from the best military experience. He says:

"The German empire had, counting lunatics, bedridden men, cripples, men over eighty and boys between seventeen and twenty, 17,000,000 males available in four categories.
