

---THE DEFENDING OFFICER: No, sir.

(Certified true copy M.F.B. 375 signed at Camp Borden, Ont., 15 April, 1943, is marked Exhibit "H," signed by the president, read, and attached to the proceedings.)

---THE WITNESS: I also produce M.F.M. 216, a Certificate of Apprehension signed by E. O. Snelgrove, Lieutenant, in charge No. 5 Section, No. 30 Canadian Provost Corps, Windsor, Ontario.

Q-11 And whom does that document refer to?

A- It refers to the accused.

---THE PRESIDENT: (To Defending Officer) Have you any objection?

---THE DEFENDING OFFICER: No, sir.

(M.F.M. 216 dated at Windsor, Ont., 6 July, 1943, is marked Exhibit "I," signed by the President, read, and attached to the proceedings.)

---THE WITNESS: I also produce M.F.B. 1481 signed by Officer Issuing Transport Warrant, Lieut. Snelgrove, E. O. No. 30 Provost Corps, No. 5 Section.

Q-12 And whom does that document refer to?

A- It refers to the accused.

---THE PRESIDENT: (To Defending Officer) Have you any objection?

---THE DEFENDING OFFICER: No, sir; I have no objection, sir.

(M.F.B. 1481 dated At Windsor, Ont., 7 July, 1943, is marked Exhibit "J," signed by the President, read, and attached to the proceedings.)

---THE WITNESS: I also produce M.F.B. 1481 signed by Officer Issuing Transportation, Lieut. F. F. Dixon, Officer issuing transport warrant, M.D. 1.

Q-13 And whom does that document refer to?

A- It refers to the accused.

---THE DEFENDING OFFICER: I have no objection, sir.
