Each nominee is exempt from the payment of yearly fees, amounting to \$90 for the three years' course, besides the fee for a B. A. degree. There being some forty certificates conferring this privilege, it is easy for students to obtain it. If a scholarship is held besides, nearly the whole cost of the education will be covered. The Calendar supplies all necessary information with regard to these nominations.

A general statement of the financial condition of the University is appended.

The Collegiate School has been well attended during the past year. The number of pupils has averaged fifty-three each term; forty-three being boarders and ten day scholars. The health of the boys has been remarkably good, and their general conduct most satisfactory.
