pensive bom mission could remain long enough in one place to determine the best sites for future reservations or where industrial communities ought to be located.

Queen Charlotte's Islands, for instance, in my opinion, now afford a splenaid full from enter-- prising hussionary and an inaus - brial hission such as the one I have given especial reference to The Tydas are quite equal to the Tsimpsheeans, ambitions to enjoy the results of their reformation, and isolated as they are from local contamenation with the view of the whites, would become a most useful and orderly community with comparatively with difficulty. If encouraged in arts or manufactures they would make great progress, and with school assistance he self support-
