ST. JOHN FIRM OVERCOMES THE DISASTROUS EFFECTS OF FIRE AND GETS A HANDSOME NEW HOME.

The Canadian Drug Company Moves Into Its Own New Premises in Mill Street—A Description of the Handsome Structure—How Property Has Risen in Value in This City.

A business house which, in its line, is without a peer this side of Montreal, is the new home of the Canadian Drug Company, 20 and 31 Mill street.

On the 17th of the month, eight months ago, the company's quarters in Prince William street were destroyed by fire. With characteristic energy, however, the firm recommenced operations in the Horn building, Water street, and on August 1, the contract for the erection of a new and complete establishment was awarded B. McCreary & Sons; the company in the meantime having purchased ground in Mill street.

RISE IN PROPERTY VALUES HERE GREAT.

The ground adjoining that bought by the drug company, and like that, belonging to the Gilbert estate, had been purchased and was being built upon by T. H. Birt. As an illustration of the advance in the value of real estate in St. John, it may be mentioned that about five years ago there was an acre of between \$4,000 and \$5,000 on both sides.

The cost of the same, as bought by Mr. Birt, was \$10,000. The drug building, as it stands completed, is one of the most imposing and thoroughly equipped business houses to be found in the city. It is four stories in front, and in the rear is one story more. Everything about the establishment is characterized by system, completeness and superiority. Business in the new house has been in progress since early in the week, and the place when visited yesterday afternoon by a Telegraph reporter, was a hive of industry. In each department business was booming, and the twenty employees were kept rushing.

ADDS TO MERCANTILE STANDING OF ST. JOHN.

The drug company's new home is not only a valuable addition to the appearance and importance of Mill street, but has added greatly to the mercantile standing of the city and province. Formerly the retail druggists procured stock through Montreal houses; now they can be supplied in full from this local firm. Every order receives the most careful attention, and is filled with the promptitude that has always distinguished the company, and not only the customers of the house but citizens of St. John generally will offer to the company their warmest congratulations on their achievement in so signally recovering from the effects of the destructive fire of less than a year ago.

FRONT HAS BEEN MADE VERY ATTRACTIVE.

The front of brick and red granite is particularly attractive. Notably substantial yet with graceful outline, it would call for commendation in any city. The vestibule is commodious, and furnished in exceptionally good taste. The floor is tiled; the pattern being neat and handsome, and the walls and ceiling are effectively shaded and decorated. Inter-

ing through a doorway of heavy oak, the visitor is impressed with the excellent lighting facilities, the bright and clean appearance of the office and sample rooms. The street is reached by large plate glass windows, and to the right of the entrance are the offices of the manager and president, each neatly furnished in steel and high grade wood. The entire floor space of the premises and the sample room space outside is 50x20 feet. The sample room is finished in tastefully patterned steel, and partitioned from the remainder of the first floor by a large glass partition, extending from floor to ceiling. This first floor which, like all the others, is 50x20 feet, is so arranged that the display of goods can be examined to the best possible advantage. Passing from the office and sample room in the front

of the first floor to the rear, the visitor finds the rest of the first floor given over to the display of patent medicines, the best and highest grade to be found in the market. All orders are here handled. There are nine roomy windows in the rear, and there are six rows of shelves, upon which are displayed all that is known to the patent medicine market. This department is finished in white.

DRURY LANE NEEDS CIVIC ATTENTION

Descending to the basement, which is floored with asphalt, one can secure a good idea of the substantial and sound character of the building. Here is stored

reserve stocks of Patent male extract, Peruna, mineral waters, lime juice, alum, and liver oil, and other goods in large quantities. The basement is lighted by electricity, and has six windows in the rear and three in front. The basement is so constructed that teams can back in when goods are being received or shipped.

This is not in operation yet, however, on account of the delay in getting the elevator to the second floor. The aldermen agreed to remove the brow from the Drury lane hill, in the rear, and lower the grade on the street. That is an important matter, which the common council should consider. A building such as the drug company has erected will add to the city treasury by reason of taxes and water rates. A number of firms which have built along Mill street have not asked any con-

cesses of the city, and the least the city could do would be to see that the street is put in proper condition for building purposes.

THE "SUNDRY ROOM" DESERVES ITS NAME.

Reascending by the stairway or electric elevator (the Otis Canadian Elevator Co.) the next floor seen is the second. Concerning this elevator, it may be mentioned that it is of the latest and of most improved type. It is situated in the north-west corner, is fitted with automatic doors, thus making it absolutely impossible for any accident to occur in the elevator shaft.

The second floor is called the "Sundry room." Here is an almost infinite variety of playing cards, pipes, soaps, rubber goods, atomizers, syringes, powders, brushes, whisks, perfumes—all new, fresh, high class goods. Every manner of surgical appliance, and the hundred and one complex articles which go to complete the equipment of the modern pharmacy, are here found in the most satisfying variety.

Continuing to the third floor by an easy and ornate stairway, the visitor receives an object lesson in what a well stocked drug department means. Here the shelves are crowded with packages, bottles and boxes of drugs, pills, fluid extracts, herbs, antiseptics, and home and foreign goods in almost bewildering variety is here shown. The Park Davis Company is prominently represented; also the Wampoles, Stearns and Weyhe, concerns—all houses of sterling reputation.

PLACE FOR EVERYTHING, AND RULE IS KEPT.

While the press representative was being shown over the department a large consignment of goods from E. Merck, Darmstadt was being opened. The stock is advantageously arranged—there is a place for everything, and everything is where it is supposed to be.

A large room in the southwest corner of the floor—in fact it occupies about a quarter of the floor space—is devoted to manufacturing medicines. When viewed yesterday afternoon, it was one of the busiest sections in the establishment. Here such preparations as Hager's Balsam and Tonic, Dr. Merck's German Remedy, Higgins' British Liniment, Briggs' Black-berry Syrup were being made and bottled. The curative properties of these preparations is simply attested by the great public demand there is for them.

RUSHING FOR THE CHRISTMAS TRADE.

In addition to the work being done in connection with those medicines, large quantities of soap and lime juice were being bottled. Here can also be found special facilities for the cleaning of bottles, and the delay, which occasionally has been made in this department has been overcome. Like all the floors, there is a well appointed cloak room and lavatory adjoining.

On the top floor—the fourth—cream of stout, ale, broken packages, cases of bottles, and empty cases and barrels. Like the floors below, this one is bright, and tastefully painted, and it is a model establishment, and to its proprietors, the community at large will wish every prosperity.
