After nominations were all made, and nomination closed, on motion of Mr. John Willet,

Resolved, That, in the event of a tie vote, those having a majority vote be declared elected, but that a vote be taken on the tie vote to fill up the required number of nine.

The Moderator submitted the Report of the Session.

On motion the same was received and adopted, and entered on the Minutes.

Mr. Sommerville presented the Report of the Sabbath School, which was, on motion, received and entered on the Minutes.

Mr. Peter Chisholm read the Report of the Portland Branch Sabbath School, which was received and entered on the Minutes.

On motion, Resolved, That this Church considers it its duty to pay the rent of the Sabbath School in Portland.

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
