of abetting, procuring or counfelling any Petit Treason, then and in every such case such woman or women shall be subject and liable to such surther pains and penalties as are particularly specified and declared with respect to persons convicted of wilful murder, in an Act, passed in the twenty-fifth year, of the Reign of King George the second, intituled, "An Act for better preventing the horrid crime of murder," and the Court before whom any such woman or women shall be convicted, shall pass sentence at such time, and shall give such orders with respect to the time of execution, the disposal of the convict's body after execution and all such other matters and things, as are directed to be given by the said Act, with respect to persons convicted of wilful murder.
