

No immediate plans for Hwy. 403 here

HAMILTON - Highway 403 from Aberdeen Ave. to Highway 2, near Duff's Corner, will be opened for traffic Wednesday, Aug. 27.

With this new, 6.7-mile stretch of freeway, it will be possible to drive on Hwy. 403 from the Queen Elizabeth Way east of Hamilton to Hwy. 2 west of Hamilton, a distance of about 16 miles.

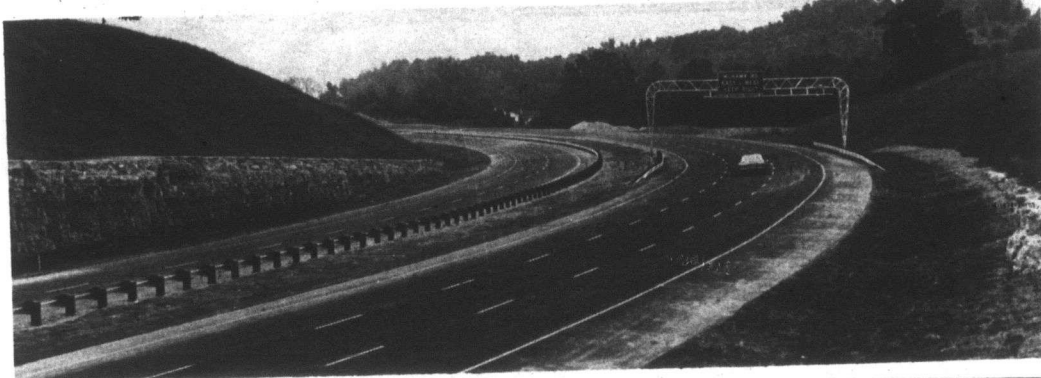
Access to the city of Hamilton will be provided by means of a series of interchanges.

Built at a cost of \$10,400,000, the new freeway is a

four-lane highway separated by a depressed median ranging in width from 34 feet to 74 feet. An extra truck climbing lane is provided for west-bound traffic on the two-mile grade carrying the freeway over the Niagara Escarpment.

Eventually, the freeway will be extended east through Mississauga and connected to Hwy's 401 and 27 at the present 401-27 interchange.

However, according to department of transport officials, there is no definite date set for such an extension.

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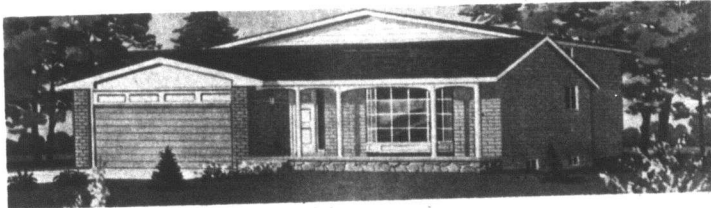
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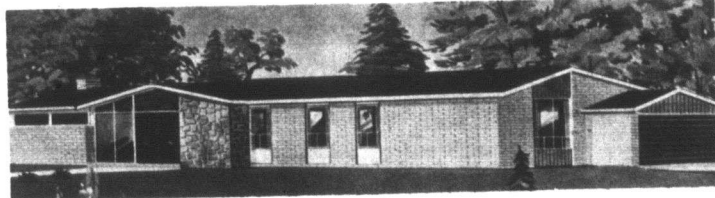

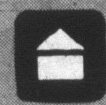
