THIS LETTER HAS BEEN SENT

Sir.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your reference No 1084, being a copy of letter addressed to you by Mr. Agent Begg, having reference to the Crown Dues payable by Messrs Carling and Lake on a number of Railway Ties cut on the Blackfoot Timber Limit, and in reply to inform you that these ties should be seized at once under the provisions of the Indian Act section 62, as amended by 50-51 Victoria Chap 33 section 6, provided they are known to be taken from the limit. The exact number should be ascertained, including Culls, and dues at ordinary tariff rate should be collected thereon together with the costs of seizure and apprehension. With regard to the letter of 26th Nov. Inst - File 94200 - I may state that the words "Blackfoot Indian Reserve" were intended to apply to the Timber Reserve or Limit.

As there is no timber on the old Reserve reference could not apply to it.
