Church parade for R.C. personnel on Duty Watch at 0820 hours and Protestant personnel at 0940 hours. The band and Flt.Lt. J.M. Roe, Station Chaplain, attended a memorial dedication service near Cochrane, Alberta, to the late Sergeant Pilot Regimbal, A and R.67694 LAC Chace, Q.B. killed in a flying accident 17th February, 1941. Flt.Lt. R.H. Batty and Flt.Lt. R.D. Byers landed during the day with aircraft piloting the Hon. J.B. Bowen, Lieutenant Governor of Alberta, en route to unveiling ceremony at Cochrane. Further party of 15 airmen sent to scene of crash at 1400 hours to assist in bringing out casualties. Whole party including Commanding Officer, Sqn.Ldr. F.J. Cheesman and Flt.Lt. A.R. McManus, M.O.'s, F.O. J.B. Lawrie, F.O. F.C. Manning, F.O. V.C. Howie and airmen and civilians returned in the evening with LAC McGruther, A.M.R. who was taken to the Colonel Belcher Hospital, and remains of F.O. I.M.S. Brown and R.87072 LAC Greenfield, F.W. at 1815 hours, Commanding Officer in charge of attending party. Flt.Lt. D.G. Pickard in charge of funeral party, Pilot Officer B.C. Ward in charge of escort party, Flying Officer W. Abercromby, F.O. J.P. Barsalou, F.O. R.F. Carey, F.O. D.S. Jacobs, F.O. W.N. Mackinnon, F.O. L.H. Witherspoon supporting party.
