July 21st and 22nd, I visited the Whitefish Lake Reserve and found everything out there going on alright. Those ill with small-pox, ten in all, are recovering rapidly and there has been no further cases on the reserve so far. Dr. Ayles visited all the Indians during his trip to Whitefish Lake Reserve, which he placed in quarantine and left for home on the 7th inst. He will return to the Agency again on the 16th proximo to raise the quarantine should there be no more cases of the disease between now and that date.
