

between Parny Island and Horn  
Point including Horn Island.

Any sluice upon timber cut by  
you upon the Island between Parny  
Island Channel and Horn Point  
including Horn Island will therefore  
be payable to the Officers of the Depart-  
ment of Crown Lands of Ontario,  
with which Office you must also  
arrange for the removal of the timber  
already cut or for the future cutting  
of timber on any of those Islands.

The Commissioner of Crown Lands  
has been informed that if he will  
protect you in the possession of the  
timber on such of the Islands  
included in your license as belong  
to the Ontario Government, his  
Department will be prepared to pay  
over to his Department an equitable  
proportion of the Bonus and ground rent  
paid.
