I beg to inform you that Mr Agent Mann, under date the 9th August, wrote the Department again in regard to the case of Julie the wife of James Tak-ko-chin nee Cardinal. It appears from what the Agent states that this woman was legally married to James Tah-ko-chin in July 1898. In view of this fact I have to request that you will advise the Department of the amount of scrip which she received, in order that it may know what sum should be recouped to the Department before she can be paid treaty money.


