In compliance with the request of the Department I now have the honour to inform you that at a public meeting held at Port Simpson on mednesday November the Elst 1906 a majority of the male members of the band being present the following resolution was carried after hours of discussion by almost a unanimous vote.

house on the South end of Birnie Island at the entrance of Port Simpson harbour be surrendered to His Majesty King Edward the Seventh for the Marine and Pisheries Depaytment, for lighthouse purposes, and that the sum of \$50.00 Fifty Dollars be paid to the Port Simpson Indian Council to meet Municipal expenditures from said surrender, and further that the Chief is hereby authorized to complete said surrender when presented for signature by the Department.
