- (b) The officers detailed in sub-paragraph (a) will first be in position to receive His Excellency the Governor General and Her Royal Highness on the stairway inside the Central Entrance of the Parliament Buildings at 1450 hours and will accompany His Excellency to his dressing room and thence in procession to the Senate Chamber.
- (c) When His Excellency and Her Royal Highness reach The Throne, the officers in the procession will wheel to the right and left of The Throne and take up position against the north wall of the Senate Chamber.
- (d) On conclusion of the ceremony, the Procession will be re-formed and will accompany His Excellency to his dressing room, thence to the Central Entrance of the Parliament Buildings.
- <u>Dress</u> Service Dress Drill Order Brown Kid Gloves will be worn - No Sticks - Mourning Bands will be worn.
- Major W. M. Thompson, Grey & Simcoe Foresters is appointed Field Officer-in-Waiting.

Captain J. Leal, R.C.A.S.C., is appointed assistant to the Field Officer-in-Waiting.
