- 2.54 You have eighteen months service -- is that what you said?
- A.54 Yes, Sir.
- Q.55 Now when you enlisted did you have one made up -- this 800?
- Yes, Sir. I saw one at Longue Pointe when I was issued with A.55 equipment.
- Q.56 You saw one then?
- Yes, Sir, for we gave it back after basic training was over; all my web equipment and pack except my small pack. A.56
- It is only since last summer, 1948, that you were issued with web equipment and pack? 2.57
- Yes, Sir. A.57
- Are you married? 0.58
- A.58 No, Sir.
