IT WAS RESOLVED

THAT the program for the expansion of the technical facilities of the Corporation over the next few years is accepted in principle as submitted, and that the General Manager be authorized, in consultation with the Chairman, to negotiate with the Government to obtain the funds required for the financing of this technical expansion plan on the best terms possible.

It was agreed that the item on television submitted in the proposed plan be taken out and brought to the attention of the Government separately. It was felt that the CBC should not ask for a loan from the Government for television, but that an item for such purpose might be covered by a special grant.
