Brigadier: "The Brigade will Halt."

C.O.'s will repeat this order and —th Battalion.

Brigadier's Signal (when at 30 paces).

C. O.'s: "Halt."

The Bands stop playing on the command—"Halt."

Brigadier: "General Salute."

On this command, the procedure will be as when receiving the Reviewing Officer.

Brigadier: "The Brigade will Slope."
Procedure as already described.

Brigadier: "Officers and Colours will take Post."
Procedure as already described.

Brigadier: "Brigade will Order."

C.O.'s will repeat this order, then—

G. O.'s: "—th Battalion," and on—

Brigadier's Signal.

C. O.'s: "Order Arms."

The Brigade will then await for further orders from the Reviewing Officer.

## ROYAL REVIEW

Procedure will be as already described, with these exceptions: Substitute the command Royal Salute for General Salute. When the Brigade Presents Arms, the Bands will play the National Anthem, and the Colours will be lowered to the front till the head of the pike rests on the ground. In wet or muddy weather, the Colours will be gathered in the hand, to prevent them from becoming soiled.
