V.

That a Register be kept, in which shall be inserted the Deliberations of the general Meetings, another to regard the proceedings of the Directors, the annual Accounts of the Treasurer, and other papers relative to the Establishment &c. And a third Register to insert the Names of Subscribers, or others who may make any Donation to the Library, whether of Books, or other Property, a description of which shall be particularly stated in such Register.

VI.

Whenever the Library amounts to five hundred Volumes it shall be opened to the Subscribers, every Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday, from ten in the morning to three o'Clock in the afternoon; each Subscriber may take and retain a Folio Volume twelve days, or a quarto ten days, or two Octavos or Duodecimos eight days, on giving a Receipt to the Librarian, but Plans, Maps, Globes and Mathematical Instruments shall not be removed.

VII.

Any Subscribers failing to return a Book, within the time prescribed, to be deprived of the use of the Library until it is returned, and to pay besides a fine of ten shillings, and any Book torn or injured in the hands of a Subscriber, to be replaced, or paid for by him its full value or that of the set to which it may belong; and until such Book, or set of Books are replaced or paid for, the Subscriber shall be deprived of the use of the Library, unless the value of the Books be deposited.

Any Subscriber neglecting for two years to pay his
