

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

THE following pages contain summaries of the papers read at the Second Annual Convention of the Homemakers' Clubs of Saskatchewan, held in Saskatoon, February 6, 7, 8 and 9, 1912. Doctor Graham's paper on the "Care of the Teeth" is the only exception. This paper was read at the short Course in Agriculture and Home Economics held in Estevan, and is included because of its intense practical value. Miss Tennant's paper on "Washday Methods" is given in full for the same reason, and also because of many requests for its publication.

There will be some disappointment among those who were fortunate enough to hear the papers read, that they are not reproduced in full. It was felt, however, that the papers would serve a more generally useful purpose by being boiled down, so to speak, and thereby made readily accessible to readers.
