Their Lordships, after having dwelt at length on the terrible injury to faith and morals which is being done by the impious press of Italy, go on to say: "But it is not enough to be on our guard against the wicked and dangerous press, we must also do everything in our power to promote the success of the good press, so that it may not happen that while the enemy is wielding with such skill the weapon of the press, preparing ruin for faith and morals, the same weapon of the press should remain unused in the hands of the good."

It is imperative, therefore, that we should oppose press to press if we are to prevent the spread of impious teachings among the people. To-morrow it may be too late. Everything points to a great battle in the near future in the social and religious field, and the principal arms employed in it will be the arms of the press.

Let everything be done, therefore, to help the Catholic press. We earnestly recommend the clergy to give the utmost possible circulation to the Catholic press, daily or weekly. It will be of great assistance also to establish popular libraries and reading circles, always, however, using the precautions necessary to prevent the danger of presenting to the people, and especially to youth, a literary food that is not quite sound."
