An Act to amend Chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes, "Of Executive and Legislative Disabilities."

(Passed the 7th day of May, A. D. 1867.)

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows:

1. No person being a member of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada, shall be capable of being appointed to, or of sitting or voting in, the Legislative Council of this Province, or of being elected to, or of sitting or voting in, the House of Assembly thereof. And if any person being a member of the Legislative Council, or of the House of Assembly of this Province, shall accept a seat in the Senate, or be elected as a member of the House of Commons of Canada, his seat in the Legislative Council or House of Assembly of this Province, as the case may be, shall thereby be vacated.

Members of Senate or House of Commons not eligible for Legislative Council or House of Assembly.

2. The provisions of the fifth section of the Act hereby amended, shall extend to the Offices of Treasurer and Commissioner of Public Works and Mines.

Sec. 5 of amended Act shall apply to office of Treasurer and Commissioner of Public Works and Mines.

CHAPTER 4.

An Act further to amend Chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes, "Of Provincial Government Railroads."

Preamble.

1. In Counties of more than one Sessional District, Custoses and Clerks of Peace to perform duties prescribed in case of single Custos, &c.

Whereas, the Custos and Clerk of the Peace respectively, in the Counties in which the railroad is being constructed, were required to perform certain duties under the said Act, and whereas there are at present in the County of Hants a Custos and Clerk of the Peace for each of the two districts in that County—

Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows:

1. In the County of Hants, and in any other County where there may be more than one Custos or Clerk of the Peace, any one or either of the said Custoses or Clerks of the Peace respectively, may and shall, within their respective districts, have under the provisions of said Act, all the authority and
