## ORDERED, That the question of concurrence be now put on the faid Address paragraph by paragraph.

And the faid Addrefs was again read by paragraphs; and, upon the queftion feverally put thereupon, agreed unto by the House.

ORDERED, That the Address be ingroffed.

ORDERED, That Mr. Justice De Bonne, Mr. Justice Panet, Mr. McGill, Mr. Craigie, Mr. Lees, Mr. Shaw, and Mr. Caron do wait upon his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor to know His Excellency's pleafure when He will be attended by this House with its Address.

On motion of Mr. McGill, feconded by Mr. Bertbelot,

ORDERED, That His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor's Speech, to both Houfes of the Provincial Parliament, be taken into confideration on Friday next.

Mr. Justice De Bonne moved to refolve, seconded by Mr, Paquet,

That this House do meet three times each week, to wit, on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, unless specially provided to the contrary by a resolution at the adjournment.

Mr. Berthelot moved, feconded by Mr. Martineau,

That the confideration of Mr. De Bonne's motion be postponed until Friday next.

Mr. Justice Panet moved, feconded by Mr. Levefque,

That the Houfe do now adjourn.

The
