

ORDERED, That the question of concurrence be now put on the said Address paragraph by paragraph.

And the said Address was again read by paragraphs ; and, upon the question severally put thereupon, agreed unto by the House.

ORDERED, That the Address be ingrossed.

ORDERED, That Mr. *Justice De Bonne*, Mr. *Justice Panet*, Mr. *McGill*, Mr. *Craigie*, Mr. *Lees*, Mr. *Shaw*, and Mr. *Caron* do wait upon his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor to know His Excellency's pleasure when He will be attended by this House with its Address.

On motion of Mr. *McGill*, seconded by Mr. *Berthelot*,

ORDERED, That His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor's Speech, to both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, be taken into consideration on Friday next.

Mr. *Justice De Bonne* moved to resolve, seconded by Mr. *Paquet*,

That this House do meet three times each week, to wit, on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, unless specially provided to the contrary by a resolution at the adjournment.

Mr. *Berthelot* moved, seconded by Mr. *Martineau*,

That the consideration of Mr. *De Bonne's* motion be postponed until Friday next.

Mr. *Justice Panet* moved, seconded by Mr. *Levesque*,

That the House do now adjourn.
