




A N A C T

For the Relief of the *Poor* in the Town of *Halifax*.



It is enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Assembly, that the Sum of One Hundred Pounds shall be assessed upon the Inhabitants of the Township of Halifax for the Relief and Support of the Poor, belonging to the said Township this Current Year; which Assessment shall be made by Five persons to be appointed Assessors, by the Justices at the next General Court of Quarter-Sessions of the Peace, to be held at Halifax, after Publication hereof, who shall Administer to them an Oath for the Due and Faithful execution of their Office, according to the best
