WEST END GROCERY.

A Large Stock and Some Long Cases.—A Lot of Judgement Dishes.

Court opened this (Tuesday) morning. His Honor Judge Reynolds presiding. The case which occupied the most time was that of

Ruth Riley v. Wm. Hillis.—W. A. Everts for plif.; A. A. Fisher for deft. A jury was empanelled, consisting of Thos. Berry, S. Scott, J. Niblock, Adol. Brown, and Stearns Rowson. This case was a sequel of a suit tried at last court, in which the plif. sued deft. for violation of the terms on which he leased a farm from the latter. Hillis set up a counter claim, and the result of it all was a verdict of \$15 for plif. Deft. being dissatisfied with the finding of the court, sought and obtained permission for a rehearing of the case. Mrs. Riley testified at the conclusion that she did not asked for enough on the former occasion and had entered a new suit against deft. The court decided to merge the two cases together.

Plif. Mrs. Riley, was sworn and deposed that the never gave deft. permission to remove straw. Lease was surrendered by mutual consent. Deft. in violation of lease, removed five loads of straw before the trial and six loads since. He also cut and damaged a maple grove. He had brought back six loads of manure. Plif.'s evidence was lengthy and similar to that given at former trial. Mahlon Wilite, Henry Davis, Wm. Kelly, Ira M. Kelly, Wm. Mott, Irwin Wilite, Albert Wilite and Arvin Judson were also called by plif. The evidence given by these witnesses was in the main corroborative of that given by plif.

Wm. Hillis, deft. deposed that he had conversations with plif. about leaving the farm, in the presence of H. Davis at one time, and Phillip Robertson at another time. He deposed that he told him that he had purchased farm and that witness could take the straw. When he was moving plif. forbade him taking the straw. The manure he had drawn to Mrs. Riley's were good loads and good stock. Fence posts, wood, was cut on plif.'s one load and kept one himself. The posts were also cut on shares, and Mrs. Riley's share was left on the farm. Of the two milk trees killed, he thought of one, but did not think the other on the farm. Did not think the three maple trees cut made half a cord of wood, value, \$1 a cord. The milk and cook house were not finished by plif. according to agreement.

John Wilite, Jas. Wilite, Phillip Robertson, Morton Wilite and Sheldon Y. Brown testified as to the value of the wood, etc., removed by deft.

Mahlon Wilite, Albert Wilite and Henry Davis were called by rethel. It will be established by their evidence that Hillis was allowed \$5 for finishing milk house, that Mrs. Hillis had remarked that it was a good place in which to keep milk, and that the loads of manure drawn by deft. were very good.

The jury after a long deliberation, returned a verdict for \$8.75, being \$6.25 less than the amount awarded at the former trial.

Sterns Ramsom and Chas. Rowsome v. S. Jackson.—The plaintiffs in this case purchased 80 lambs and 1 ram from deft., paying thereon the sum of \$5. They were to take the lambs away before snowfall. On Oct. 20, plif. went for the lambs but deft. would not let them have the lambs unless they paid \$5 for keeping them after the time deft. claimed they were to be removed, which he swore was to be within three weeks after the purchase was made. Verdict for plif. for \$13.10, damages and costs.

Ross and Wilite v. Fred Rockwood.—Judgment summons. Ordered to be committed for fifteen days.

Massey Manf. Co. v. Jos. Moulin.—Judgment summons. Ordered to pay \$1 per month.

John L. Gallagher v. Jas. Smith.—Judgment summons. Ordered to pay \$8 per month.

S. B. Williams v. Chas. P. Wilite, Richard Findlay, and Wm. Shook.—Judgment for plif. for \$57.15 and costs. Fifteen days were allowed for payment.

Colman Wilite v. Abernethy Wilite and James Smith.—Judgment for plif. by default.

Richard Arnold v. Hiram Hawkins.—Def. was ordered to pay \$1 on first of June, and \$1 per month thereafter. Massey Manf. Co. v. Wm. Shenick.—Judgment for plif. \$15 and costs. Fifteen days were allowed for payment.

A. Pariel v. Patrik Fitzgerald.—Judgment for plif. \$11.50.

Jas. Kavanagh v. J. Hudson.—Adjudged from last court. Plif. not appearing, he was nonsuited, and deft. was allowed \$2 for day besides costs of court.

H. H. Arnold v. Ransom Wing.—Judgment summons. Committed to jail for 16 days.

Dr. C. M. B. Cornell v. Wm. Hewitt.—Adjudged to next court.

Geo. W. Beach v. Arch. Wilite.—Judgment summons. Committed to jail for 10 days.

H. H. Arnold v. O. L. Mott.—Judgment summons. Committed to jail for 15 days.
