Our attention has been called by the Department of Agriculture of the Dominion Government, to the question of export of agricultural implements and machinery, with a view to bringing it before Canadian merchants and manufacturers.

An official letter has been written by Mr. Jules Joubert, Secretary of the Agricultural Society of New South Wales, representing that in that colony there is an urgent demand for improved agricultural implements and labor saving machinery; but that it is not yet in a position to purchase the requisite skill for manufacturing them.

We understand the Department of Agriculture has entered into a correspondence with Mr. Joubert, with a view of obtaining further particulars.
