His Last Unhappy Days Described by P. A. Boulanger.

A long and interesting account of Tolstoy's last days, written by P. A. Boulanger, who was at Astapovo when the writer died, has appeared in the Times. The article sets forth the motives which led to Tolstoy's departure from Yasnaya Polinna, and describes the incidents of his last journey and illness.

"When the rustle in the study cossed and Tolstoy had assured himself that the countess was asleep in her hedroom, he rose, collected his papers and went to tell his friend, by Makevitsky, that he had decaded to leave the horse at once. It was 3 o'clock in the morning.

"After closing the door into the next room, that the countess might not hear his preparations, he packed his papers and the necessary clothing. He took only two changes of under-lothing evidently considering that quite enough for his future life. Then he went to awake his youngest doughter and bade her good-bye.
