WOODSTOCK, Aug. 18.—A stiff fight is on here over the bylaw to be voted on on Monday, by which the city is asked to give a bonus of \$20,000 to the Warren & Sons Company, manufacturers of theatre and church organs.

The bylaw also includes a loan of another \$25,000, which is to be repaid to the city by writing off a certain percentage according to the labor employed. A large meeting has been held, and the bylaw is being discussed on every corner. The Warren Company has installed one of their \$10,000 organs in a local theatre and are giving nightly concerts demonstrating the organ.

FUR PRICES DROP AT

SALES IN WINNIPEG WINNIPEG, Aug. 18.—A considerable drop in prices featured the fourth fur sale by a local auction sales company here today. Two of the most noticeable price retrenchments were spring rats and beaver. The best rats went at \$1.75, with some at \$1.50, as against \$2 paid at the last auction. Beaver was sold at \$18 today, while at the last sale the ruling price was \$30. Marten showed slight signs of fluctuation, being in demand at \$18. Otter went strong at \$20: several silver fox skins were disposed of, the price ranging from \$90 to \$205, according to quality.

More than 72,000 pelts were offered for sale, which are worth approximately \$300,000. Buyers were present from Montreal, New York, Edmonton, Seattle and Minneapolis






