TEACHERS' CERTIFICATES.

The Successful Candidates and their Marks Obtained. Long List of Brevets and New Certificates—A Large Percentage of the Candidates Pass.

The board of examiners have made the following report as the result of the recent examination of candidates for certificates of qualification to teach in the public schools of this province. Of the one hundred and seventeen candidates who presented themselves, one hundred and eight took the papers in this city. In addition, four graduates of British Universities were required to take the paper on Education, thus making, in all, one hundred and twenty-one candidates.
