"DOZ TERRIBLE 'BLUFF'"

The Poker Mania in Washington—It breaks the Diplomatic Corps all up. What a fascination the great American game of poker has for the foreigner. The chief, and about the only, business of the American secretaries in Washington is to teach them poker and play with them. Turks, Franks, Spaniards, Indians, Ethiopians, Dutch, Italians, Muscovites, Mongolians, all yield to the fascinations of the American game, and the poker-playing among the foreign legations is high and fast and furious. They are made to pay pretty dearly for their experience, and some of the smart American officials pluck the gentle foreigners most unmercifully. The head of a government bureau showed me a big roll of bills the other night, and said, "Here's \$200 I win to-night from So-and-so," naming a moon-faced Mongolian minister, who goes about the city in a flowing robe of peacock blue and royal purple. The terrible thing about this soul-destroying game for the unsophisticated foreigners is the "bluff."

Bacon de Struve, who, like all others, is a tireless devotee of the game went on for some months in happy ignorance of the bluff and supposing he was a pretty expert poker player. But one evening in a little game with a mischievous young cabinet officer, he was his whole heart, soul and pocket on three aces and was bluffed by his opponent with a pair of aces. It was a new development of the possibilities of the game and its sublime possibilities dazed and bewildered the baron and, as he expressed it in good "United States" language, "broke him all up."

He said: "Oh, dear fearful, fearful American game and do terrible bluff. I did not know do bluff and what I do with it." Poker playing is the rage in all circles in Washington, high and low. There are scores of poker organizations among the attaches of the government. In the rooms of the clerks and in the hundreds of lodging-houses the game goes on. One game at Chamberlain's last week, in which were two United States senators, lasted twenty-six hours without ceasing. A party of southerners not long ago, in a rear room of the National hotel, played a game lasting from Friday evening at 9 o'clock until Monday morning at 8 o'clock.

During that time the same never ceased, cat-naps were caught in the chairs as the players sat, luncheon served regularly and the amount of whisky drunk and tobacco smoked and chewed to keep awake was something awful to contemplate. Once the poker mania takes hold of a person it rarely lets go and it is as persistent and ruinous as the morphine habit.
