



GOOD PUMPKIN PIES .- Much depends GOOD PUMPKIN PIES.—Much depends on the way in which pumpkins are in the first place cooked. The pumpkin selected should be a good one, and be prepared in the morning and cooked all day. A little salt should be added while cooking. It must not be allowed to burn. When done it should be immediately removed from the vessel it has been cooked in. The flavour will be spoiled if it be allowed to cook in an iron vessel. After preparing the pumpwill be spoiled if it be allowed to cook in an iron vessel. After preparing the pumpkin in this way take for six pies twelve tablespoonfuls of pumpkin, four eggs, eight tablespoonfuls of sugar and six cups of new milk; season to taste—some prefer cinnamon. If the pumpkin be not rich and good, more sugar and eggs are required to bring the richness to the required standard.
