board pine. The Newville Lumber Co., of New-ville, N.S., expect to take out this winter 4,500,000 feet of iogs. Nearly all their next season's production of lumber has been sold for shipment to Great Britain.

J. J. Wheelock, of Connors, N.B., ex-J. J. Wheelock, of Connors, N.B., ex-pects to manufacture 30,000,000 shingles during the coming season, as well as a quantity of long lumber for the local trade. He has a mill at Connors, N.B., and another at St. Francis, Maine.




