the aged Saint, panting for the unseen glory, lifted up his arms in an emphatic manner, and cried out,—"Oh to be at home with Him this night! . It would be grand to hear His chariot coming for me. Glad would I be to hear Him say, 'Come up hither!' Oh to be with Him this very night!
But I must wait His time!" And thus it was when his time came. His Master took him up to the "Hill of Delights" without a groan, or a struggle, or a sigh, or a twinge of a muscle; he glided into glory with His Lord, and we saw him no more; his place is vacant, his memory is precious, his influence still fragrant.
