PREPARATION OF A "COUNTRY REPORT"

By consulting the various sections and looking up the appropriate country, a report can be compiled quickly. For example, to use the case of Italy:

- The position of that country as a world trading nation can be determined from Table I.
- The GNP, from Table II.
- The relative importance of Canada's trade with that country, from Table III.
- The figures for total trade plus the balance, from Table IV.
- The dollar volume of Canada's domestic exports to Italy, from Table V.
- The top five merchandise exports from Canada, from Table VI.
- The dollar volume of imports from Italy, from Table VII.
- The five most important imports from Italy, from Table VIII.
- The amount of Italy's direct investment in Canada, from Table IX.
- The amount of Canadian direct investment in Italy, from Table X.
- Italian migration to Canada, from Table XI.
- The number of visitors from Italy, from Table XII.
