

In addition, CIR applicants only must:

- be motivated to participate in international exchange activities; and
- have a functional command of the Japanese language.

In addition, ALT applicants only must:

- be interested in education and teaching in general;
- be interested in working actively with students; and
- be qualified as language teachers or have studied the teaching of English as a second language or be motivated to study it.

HOW DO I APPLY?

The application procedure is in two stages. Submitted application documents are screened at the Embassy of Japan and then selected candidates are interviewed for final selection at the Embassy or relevant Consulate General in Canada. Applications are usually available in early October with a December application deadline. Positions begin in late July.
