- 6. The Canadian side informed the Soviet side of the Quebec Government's desire to provide on a commercial basis various didactic and pedagogical material for various levels of schooling;
- 7. The Canadian side also informed the Soviet side of the Quebec Government's proposal to exchange on the basis of reciprocity up to two specialists for a period of one month to study the pre-elementary school systems in the Soviet Union and the province of Quebec. The sending authorities would pay international travel and the receiving authorities accommodation and living expenses;
- 8. Both sides agreed to encourage and facilitate cooperation between institutions of higher learning of each country under existing and future agreements as appropriate, including those enumerated in Annex B and C.

D. Conditions of Exchanges

1. Both sides agreed to create the conditions necessary for the fulfillment of all exchange programmes under sections A, B and C including the use of educational and scientific material, and full access to laboratories, archives and libraries. Both sides also agreed to
